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**General Information**

**The following majors may be completed, taking both day and evening courses: Allied Health Science, Biology, Biology/Psychology, Chemistry, Chemistry/Biology, Education, Exercise Science, Family and Consumer Science Education, French, General Science, History, Information Technology, International Business Foreign Language, Mathematics, Mathematics/Computer science, Music, Music Education, Music Therapy, Nutrition, Political Science/International Relations, Spanish, Sociology, Social Work, Criminology.**

5. Maximum number of credits accepted in transfer: **64**
