Note 1: Penn State Abington's Business Degree has Options in Accounting, Financial Services, Health Services, Individualized Studies, and Marketing and Management.

Note 2: ACCT 105 and ACCT 106 are *both* required to fulfill Penn State Abington's ACCTG 211. The additional credits transfer as Electives.

Note 3: This major requires at least 9 credits in Electives.

Note 4: The Penn State Business major requires 4 credits of Calculus. BCCC students can choose MATH 140 (which transfers as Penn State's MATH 140), or they can choose MATH 117 and MATH 118, *combined* (the equivalent of Penn State's MATH 110). For students taking MATH 117 and 118, the additional credits become Electives. See also Note 8, regarding Statistics.

Note 5: Keep track to fulfill Penn State Abington's **General Education requirements** for these majors:

- 6 credits in Arts
- 6 credits in Humanities
- 6 credits in Social and Behavioral Sciences (fulfilled by ECON 111 and 112)
- 3 credits Health and Physical Activity (Note that HLTH 200 counts as WMNST, General Education: Humanities, not Health)
- 6 credits in Quantification (fulfilled by the Penn State major requirements)
- 9 credits in Natural Sciences
- 3 credits in United States Cultures can double count with the courses listed above (example: U.S. History= both Humanities and U.S. Cultures requirement)

Note 6: The Penn State Abington Division Head has substituted the three-credit BCCC course for Penn State Abington's four-credit requirement, BA 243.

Note 7: Penn State suggests the Bucks student *take one course* in U.S. Cultures (VAFA 194, HIST 151, HIST 152, LITR 231, LITR 232, LITR 278, MUSC 105, or MUSC 106) and *one course* in International Cultures (VAFA 191, VAFA 192, VAFA 193, COMT 101, HIST 111, HIST 112, HUMN 120, or LITR 261). Foreign Language courses count as Electives for this major.

Note 8: MATH 115 and 215, *combined*, are equivalent to Penn State's STAT 200, a required, 4-credit course. The additional credits become Electives. If MATH 115 is taken alone, it will count as an Elective.

Note 9: **Additional Policies:** Transferable courses **MUST** have a grade of "**C**" or **better**. Developmental and remedial courses are **NOT** included in transferable credit. Course work from another college or university **must be evaluated separately**. Penn State Abington's degree requires a **minimum 2.0 GPA** for transfer as calculated by Penn State. Before admission, students must complete certain high school courses, including math and foreign language. See [psu.edu/admissions/](http://psu.edu/admissions/).
