Note 1: Keep track to fulfill Penn State Abington's **General Education requirements** for these majors:

- 6 credits in Arts
- 6 credits in Humanities
- 6 credits in Social and Behavioral Sciences
- 3 credits Health and Physical Activity
- 6 credits in Quantification (with at least 3 credits in Mathematics or Statistics)
- 9 credits in Natural Sciences (at least *one course* with a lab)
- 3 credits in United States Cultures, 3 credits in Other Cultures, *and* 3 credits in International Cultures can *double count* with the courses listed above (example: U.S. History= both Humanities and U.S. Cultures requirement; any Western Heritage History = both Humanities and International Cultures requirements; ANT 104 = Social/Behavioral Science and Other Cultures requirements)

Note 2: Students in these majors take at least 18 credits of Electives and 9 credits of B.A. Requirements in Arts, Humanities, Social Sciences, Natural Sciences, Quantification, and Foreign Language. Many courses in the History major will fulfill the requirements for the Major, for Electives, for B.A. Requirements, or for General Electives, depending on the student's major. Due to the flexibility of the B.A. majors, students should consider choosing a Minor; consult the Penn State transfer counselor for details.

Note 3: BCCC says take any course from this list: BIOL 101, BIOL 102, BIOL 110, CHEM 101, CHEM 121, SCIE 101, SCIE 012, or SCIE 103.

Note 4: Take any one of these courses. Note that Penn State requires 3 credits of Health and Physical Activity.

Note 5: Certain new history courses have not yet been evaluated by Penn State. See Note 2.

Note 6: BCCC says take one course from this list: MATH 101, 102, 115, 117, 120, 122, 125, or 140.

Note 7: Student entering Penn State *History* majors should take one of the following courses: HIST 149, 154, 159, 160, 170, 172, 178, or 230 to fulfill a major requirement in U.S. History. Students entering *any other B.A. major* may take any course on the list except HIST 202 and HIST 203 (no transfer). Also note that certain courses have not yet been evaluated by Penn State: HIST 131, 141, 143, 144, 155, 156, 174, 180, 194, 204, 206, 208, 214, 218, 281, and 288.

Note 8: Take any 3-4 credit course in BIOL, CHEM, PHYS, SCIE.

Note 9: Take any course on the Social Perspectives list. Most will transfer as General Education, Social and Behavioral Sciences, except MUSC 103 can be used as General Education, Arts. See Note 10.

Note 10: Penn State suggests any of the following courses to fulfill General Education, Arts, requirement (Other courses on the Cultural Perspectives list will transfer.): VAFA 192, 193, 194, 196; COMT 101; or MUSC 101, 105, 106. See Note 1 and 2.

Note 11: **Additional Policies:** Transferable courses **MUST** have a grade of "**C**" or **better**. Developmental and remedial courses are **NOT** included in transferable credit. Course work from another college or university **must be evaluated separately**. Penn State Abington's degree requires a **minimum 2.0 GPA** for transfer as calculated by Penn State. Before admission, students must complete certain high school courses, including math and foreign language. See psu.edu/admissions/.
