\*For the B.A. degree, Penn State requires **Foreign Language** to the 12<sup>th</sup> credit level, Language 202. Penn State Foreign Language courses are 4-credit courses.

Note 1: Keep track to fulfill Penn State Abington's **General Education requirements**:

- 6 credits in Arts
- 6 credits in Humanities
- 6 credits in Social and Behavioral Sciences
- 3 credits Health and Physical Activity
- 6 credits in Quantification
- 9 credits in Natural Science (4 credits are fulfilled by a major requirement)
- 3 credits in Other Cultures (for the B.A.), *and* 3 credits in International Cultures (for B.A. and B.S.) *can double count* with the courses listed above (example: any Western Heritage History = both Humanities and International Cultures requirement; SOCI 120 = Social/Behavioral Science and Other Cultures)

Note 2: Students who took COMP 111 prior to July 2015 will receive credit for ENGL202B. Students who took it after that date will receive no transfer credit because COMP 111 transfers as COMP 110. COMP 111 is under review. Current Bucks CCC students should request permission to *substitute* COMP 114 for COMP 111 to receive credit for ENGL202C, Technical Writing.

Note 3: B.S. in Psychological and Social Sciences requires math through calculus, BCCC Math 140 *or* MATH 117 *and* 118, combined.

Note 4: Take any 3- or 4-credit BIOL, CHEM, or SCIE.

Note 5: Penn State suggests one of the following LITR courses to fulfill the International Cultures requirement: LITR 205, 206, 234, 254, 255, or 278. See Note 1.

Note 6: Penn State suggests one of the following to meet the General Education, Arts, requirement: COMT 101 or 103; MUSC 101, 105, or 106; VACV 142; VAFA 100, 107, 111, 141, 160, 161, 171, 181, 191, 192, 193, or 194.

Note 7: **Additional Policies:** Transferable courses **MUST** have a grade of **“C” or better**. Developmental and remedial courses are **NOT** included in transferable credit. Course work from another college or university **must be evaluated separately**. Penn State Abington’s Psychological and Social Sciences major requires a **minimum 2.0 GPA** for transfer as calculated by Penn State. Before admission, students must complete certain high school courses, including math and foreign language. See [psu.edu/admissions/](http://psu.edu/admissions/).
